(4) How to Install WithSecure on Mac

1. Before You Begin (Mac Version)

Connect the Mac you want to install WithSecure on to the campus wireless LAN "000saga-u" and make sure it has internet access.

If you're using a Mac with an M1 chip, you may be prompted to install Rosetta when running software designed for Intel processors.

Please follow the instructions to install Rosetta. Once installed, Rosetta will not need to be installed again.

2. How to Install WithSecure

This is the installation procedure for WithSecure on macOS Monterey (version 12).

① Open your browser (Safari) and go to the Computer and Network Center website.

Click on "Campus-Only Software Download Site", then select "WithSecure Antivirus Software".

Note: You can only access this site while connected to the campus network.

③ When the Identification screen appears, click the Next button.



4 The WithSecure download page will be displayed.

Select option 7(for students) or option 8 (for faculty/staff), then click Download to get the installation file



(5) Click Downloads on the taskbar.



Click the downloaded file to begin the installation.



6 Click [Allow].



(7) Click [Continue] on the WithSecure installation screen.



Click [Continue].



Click [Install].



Enter your Mac login password then click [Install Software].



WithSecure installation will now start.



When "Installation completed" appears, click [Close].



Click [Move to Trash].



When the "System Extension Blocked" screen appears, click [OK].




After the installation is complete, WithSecure will launch automatically. Click "Allow notifications from WithSecure Client Security for Mac"



Click [Open System Settings].



System Settings will open. Click "WithSecure Client Security for Mac" and enable "Allow Notifications"





Once "Allow Notifications" is enabled, WithSecure will display the message "Your computer is protected".
