

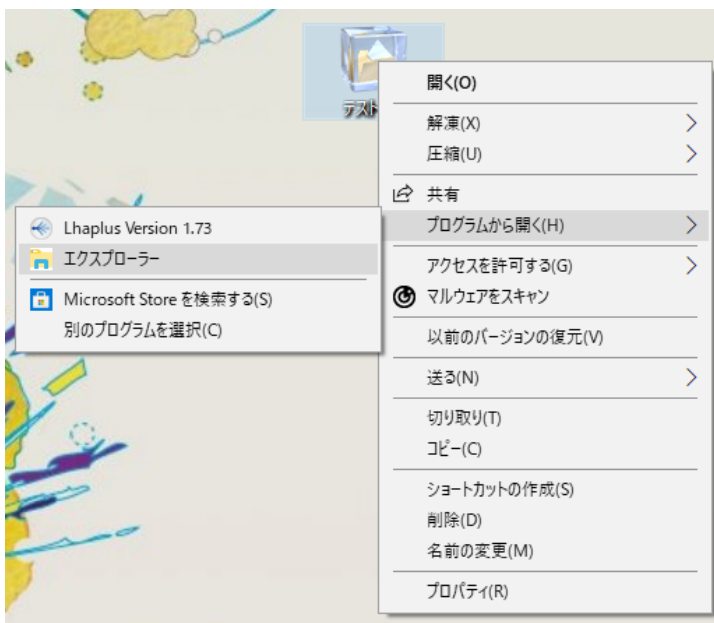
How to prevent garbled folder and file names when decompressing compressed files created by downloading OneDrive folders

In Windows, a compressed (Zip) file is created when a folder or multiple files are downloaded together from OneDrive.

If you decompress this compressed file with a decompression app, Japanese folder names and file names may be garbled.

The following is a method to save folder and file names without garbling them when decompressing.

Right-click the compressed file and select "Explorer" under "Open from Program."



Grab the folder and "copy & paste" it to the desktop, etc.
